Reference from last meeting idea suggestions:

Theme additions

- Rules put on display, when a rule gets added or removed that is reflected on the display.
 - Making a cool way to remove/destroy the rule
- ID Badge: Needs card to do certain things at camp, may be a way to track social credit score

- Social Credit Score: Points awarded to people based on winning games, doing things to help camp, etc. Points deducted for “anti-dictatorship actions,” etc.
