

Winter Camp XLII Scouts Own Hike

*Note: This hike Begins at Trout Lake Cabin and ends in the direction of the Cross Country Golf course. Coordinate with the Youth Leader to make sure that the necessary equipment is in place to start that game at the conclusion of this hike.*

*Starting Point: Outside Trout Lake Cabin*

Leader 1: Please join me in reciting the Scout Oath and Law. *Recite Scout Oath and Law*

*Second Stop: Lakeview Cabin (on the side where you can see Trout Lake)*

*Third Stop: Hill Top Cabin*

Leader 4: Think about someone you respect. What are the ways that he or she lives his or her life that are different from you? What can you change about yourself to be more like that person? Consider these questions as we work toward our next destination.

*Fourth Stop: Trailside Pavilion*

Leader 5: Thank you for joining me on this hike. Let's remember that one of the ways to fulfill our duty to God is to help others. This too is part of the Scout Oath.
